



Your account

The Companies Office has introduced a mandatory [igovt logon](#) and user registration process.

To use the Companies Office online services you will need to be logged on as a registered user. For example, if you want to file an annual return, incorporate or register a company, or maintain a company's details, you will need to be a registered user.

You can either register as an individual user (where you want to use Companies Office services for your own purposes) or register on behalf of an organisation (for instance if you will be using Companies Office services as part of your job)



You do not need to be a registered user (or logged on) to [search](#) the register.

The igovt logon service allows you to use the same logon to access various government online services. This saves you from having to remember multiple logon details for different services. The igovt logon service is secure and maintains your privacy.
