This section contains all the main government transactions you can do online, such as filing GST and tax returns, forming a company, applying for intellectual property rights, and searching the Insolvency Register.

As government departments move from paper-based systems to online systems, you will find more opportunities to streamline your processes and ideally lower your compliance costs (primarily, the time you spend on these activities).

The advantages for you?

- **Quicker.** There's no need to wait for the post (and hope that the mail will get through in time, if there is a deadline to meet), and it's quicker to fill in the returns.
- **Easier.** Less complicated form to fill in, with online help available if you need it.
- **Intuitive.** Online forms tell you when you have made a mistake, and allow you to experiment with examples and demonstrations.
- **Easy to delegate.** Give key staff access to online filing so you don't have to do it.
