How do I take out a resource?

Material such as books, journals and study guides are available on loan to procurers in the State sector.

Applications for loan of material are to be made through the Interlibrary loan service.

Many public sector organisations are already members of the Interlibrary loan service. If you wish to borrow anything, please ask your organisation's library to request it on Interloan for you.

To ensure fair access to all, the following conditions will apply:

- Maximum loan period - one month (subject to demand & availability)
- Maximum of two concurrent loan items per agency
- Most other standard library conditions apply – eg. books back on time, lost books charged to agency, etc.
