The Treasury

At the Treasury our job is to help the Government to improve economic performance and manage scarce resources. All of this is focused on improving living standards for New Zealanders.

The Treasury performs three roles:

- ▶ We provide policy advice directly to Ministers to improve the economic and fiscal conditions for high levels of economic growth and improved living standards.
- ▶ We provide services, mainly, monitoring and managing the financial affairs of the Crown, including managing the Crown's debt through the New Zealand Debt Management Office and supporting New Zealand's economic performance through the provision of services through the Export Credit Office, Crown Wholesale Guarantee Facility and the Deposit Guarantee Scheme.
- ▶ We assess and test other government agencies' advice and proposals which have economic and financial implications, and provide leadership, with other central agencies, to develop a high performing State sector.

The Treasury provides advice and services through twenty output classes provided to the Minister of Finance, the Minister for Infrastructure, the Minister for State Owned Enterprises, the Minister responsible for Vote Crown Research Institutes (Minister of Research, Science and Technology) and the Minister for Infrastructure and Minister for Regulatory Reform. .

The Treasury - Procurement Plan Outlook

The Treasury over the next 12 months plan to approach the market through an open tender process to enter into contracts for training services, and telecommunications.
